REHABILITATION OF NIRMAYA RAMESHWAR GIRLS HIGH SCHOOL, JHARKHAND

Nirman Foundation has rehabilitated the building of Nirmaya Rameshwar Girls High School at Motiya Village in Godda district of Jharkhand. This is the only girl's school in 10 km radius which was in danger of getting shut down due to structural damage of the building.

We at Nirman feel educating a girl child is the most important steps towards building a nation, we can be proud of. We have reconstructed the school, starting with the roof, expanding the classrooms, construction of toilets and added with other development facilities such as:-

- Installed deep bore-well for water facility
- Tables and benches were arranged
- Fans in the classroom were also donated
- Almirah for keeping books and files
- An Inverter was provided for power supply
- Setting up Computers and printers for skill development
- Providing School uniform to all the students

As the infrastructure was developed with all the basic facilities the number of students was increased to 60. The school is providing education to the poorest section of the society in this village.
